

**RUSHVILLE CITY COMMON COUNCIL
TUESDAY, AUGUST 2, 2011

The Rushville City Common Council met on the above date and time at 270 W 15th Street, Rushville, Indiana. Mayor Bostic called the meeting to order at 6:20 p.m., with Allen Shelton, Bob Bridges, Mike Buckley, Bill Goins, and Cindy Humphrey answering role call.
