

# MEETING OF THE CITY OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA

## BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

OCTOBER 18, 2016  
5:30 P.M.

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**CALL TO ORDER:** The City of Rushville Board of Public Works and Safety met on the above date and time at 270 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Rushville, Indiana. Mayor Pavey called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

**ROLL CALL:** Gary Cameron, Ron Jarman, and Dr. John Williams answered roll call. Darrin McGowan was not present. Also present was City Attorney, Tracy Newhouse.

**MINUTES:** Cameron moved to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2016 meeting as presented. Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** None.

**CLERK-TREASURER'S REPORT:** None.

**DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:**

**Police** – Chief Tucker handed out September reports.

Tucker said the new K-9 is being conditioned to his handler, Officer Faw. They should be on the road by the end of the week.

**Fire** – Chief Jenkins handed out September reports. He said the calls are up from last year at this time.

**Street** – Commissioner Miller reported that they filled 23 dumpsters for heavy trash pick-up. This constituted a cost of \$23,111.00.

The haunted hay ride will be October 29<sup>th</sup> from 7:00-11:00. They have 35 volunteers.

**CITIZEN CONCERNS/COMMENTS** – None.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

1. **Rushview Mobile Home Park Construction Report** – Copley said she is expecting the second grant draw sometime this week.
2. **Fire Department Hiring** – All testing with Perf has been passed. Jenkins will need to discuss the start date with Perf.

3. **Resolution 2016-25 Adoption of Title VI Policy and Plan** – Williams moved to give a favorable recommendation to Council for the resolution. Jarman seconded the motion. Motion carried.
4. **Code Enforcement Recommendation on Permitting** – Mayor Pavey is reviewing.
5. **Community Connections Contract and Bid Schedule** – Paul Vincent with Fleis & Vandenbrink read the following bids:

**Project #1: Pavement Sealing:**

1. Crim & Sons - bid complete - \$879,304.40

**Resurfacing #2:**

1. Crim & Sons – bid complete - \$932,531.60
2. Dave O'Mara – bid complete - \$843,326.52
3. Milestone – bid complete - \$924,775.40
4. Robertson Paving – bid complete - \$851,313.50

Williams made a motion to table for review by Fleis & Vandenbrink. Jarman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **Full-Time Sanitation Department Hire** – Commissioner Miller asked the Board to consider hiring Tyler Workman as a full time employee. His salary would start at \$13.75 per hour with a 90-day probation period. His pay would then increase to \$14.23 after obtaining a CDL. Cameron moved to approve hiring Workman with a start date of October 17<sup>th</sup>. Jarman seconded the motion. Motion carried.
2. **INDOT Supplemental Contract Environmental** – Due to findings at the site additional testing was necessary in the amount of \$104,531.00. Indot approved with an 80/20 split, with the City's portion being \$20,906.00. Williams moved to approve the supplemental contract. Cameron seconded the motion. Motion carried.

3. **F & V Contract for Supplemental Services Environmental** – Williams moved to approve the contract with Fleis & Vandenbrink. Cameron seconded the motion. Motion carried.
  
4. **INDOT Cherry Street Phase II – Early Coordination Meeting** – We have been approved for phase II. A meeting will be set up in November.

**ITEMS NOT KNOWN IN ADVANCE:** None.

**ADJOURN:** There was no further business to come before the Board; Cameron moved to adjourn. Jarman seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
