

**AMPHITHEATER MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2013
7:00 P.M.**

The Amphitheater Board met on the above date and time at City Hall, 133 West First Street, Rushville.

Sharpe reported our liability insurance is \$1,000.00 deductible on the damaged tent.

Sharpe reported Plum Creek will need a tent. Rathz has a tent rented for Friday and Sandy will need a tent for Rush Fest on Saturday.

Grocox stated the Gospel Sing went real well. They thanked the Amphitheater committee for the use of the venue.

The wrap up party will be October 19th at the cabin at Camp Attabury for those who would like to go. Get with Kim if you would like to stay in cabin or just come on Saturday for the picnic.

Saturday, September 21st Rush Fest festivities consist of Masonic Breakfast at 6:00 a.m. parade line up at 10:00, parade at 11:00, vendors start at 9:00 a.m., poker run sign up at 11:00 and ride begins at 1:00. Riders will be back around 4:00 and eat at the Elks tent. The City Employee Picnic will start around 5:00 p.m. at the tent. Everyone is to bring a dessert to share as we did last year. The poker run participants will get wrist bands for the food tent and the city employee will get tickets for the food tent.

Setup for concert will be Friday, September 20th at 6:00 p.m.
