

RECYCLING TOTERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM CURBS WITHIN 24 HOURS OF COLLECTION

Rushville, Ind. – March 25, 2015 – With Fridays being recycling collection day Citywide, residents are reminded their toters must be removed from curbs within 24 hours following collection.

Just as trash should be placed in alleys by 7:00 a.m. for collection on designated trash days, recycling toters should be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. every Friday.

According to Mayor Mike Pavey, the revitalized trash and recycling program launched last summer provided significant efficiencies for residents and the City as a whole.

“We created this program to encourage uniformity and compliance with our trash and recycling collection service and did a big roll-out last summer to launch the initiative. Our goal is to have all residents doing their part to clean up Rushville and keep our community looking its best for everyone who lives, works and travels through our city. Toters left curbside for days on end defeats that goal.

“With spring almost here, making our city clean and green comes in all forms. An easy way for residents to help is to remove toters from curbs within 24 hours after their recyclables are collected. It takes all of us working together to make a difference in our civic pride and environmental awareness; to revitalize Rushville,” Pavey said.
